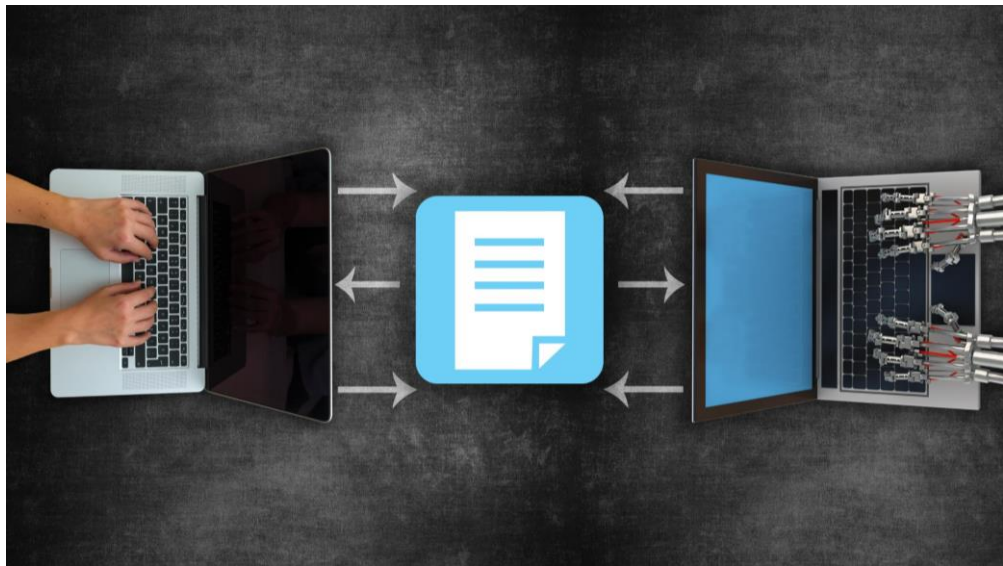

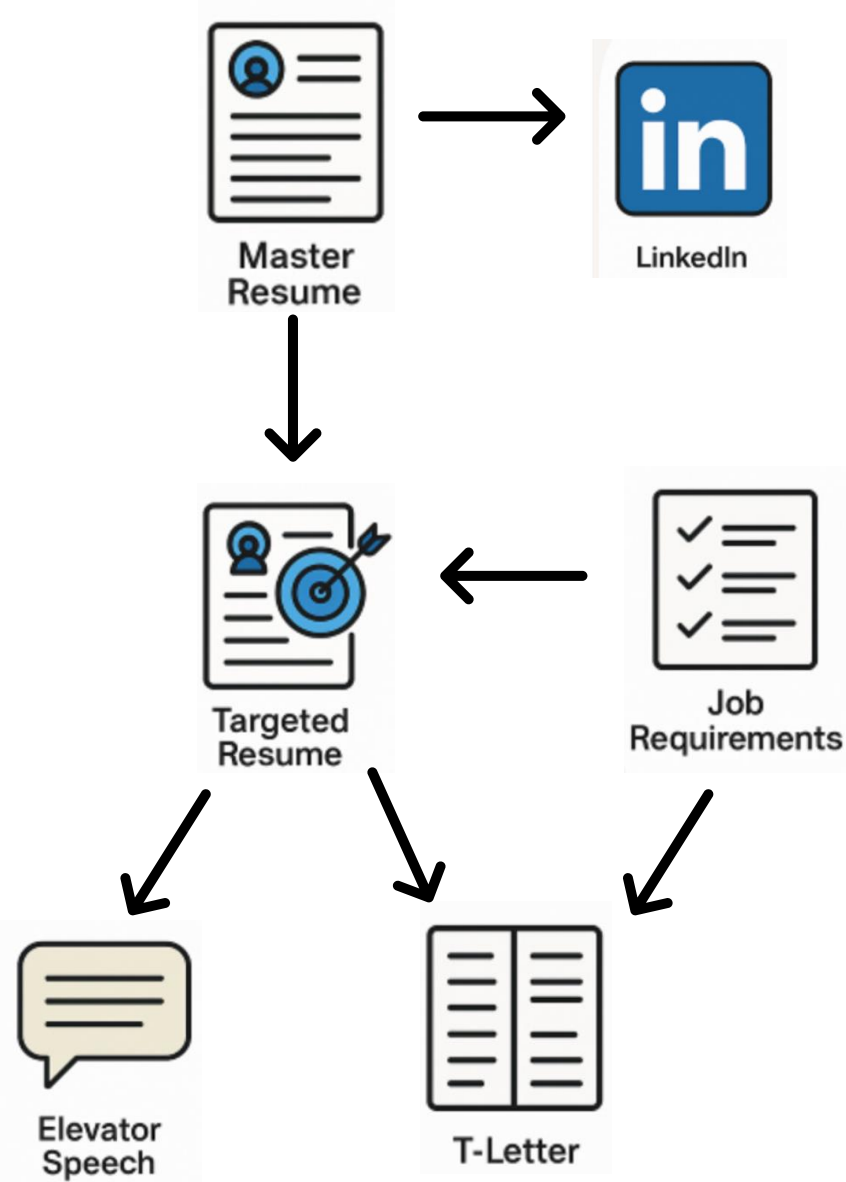

The Master Resume — Your Strategic Foundation



What It Is

A complete, verified record of your experience, achievements, skills, and impact, used as the foundation for all other job search materials.



Why It Matters

It serves as the single source of truth from which all other artifacts are generated.

it ensures accuracy and consistency.



EXAMPLE: SAMPLE MASTER RESUME EXPERIENCE

AI Makes Your Resume Stronger — You Make It Accurate

AI fills in gaps when your resume lacks details but not always with facts.

AI uses patterns from millions of examples not your actual experience.

If your resume is vague or missing details, AI may guess or generalize.

What sounds impressive might not be accurate or reflect your true skills.

Prompt Templates



What They Are

- Pre-built instructions that standardize how you use AI
- Used for repeatable or complex tasks
- Saved and reused across sessions or tools
- Can be versioned and improved over time

Why They Matter

- **Speed** — no need to write prompts from scratch
- **Consistency** — reliable outputs across roles and sessions
- **Control** — you define inputs, format, tone, and constraints
- **Quality** — reduces drift, scope creep, and hallucinations

Executing a Prompt Template

1. Provide Your Source Materials

- Upload files using the **+** icon (or the tool's upload feature)
Or **paste content directly into the chat** if uploads aren't supported
- Include all required inputs (Master Resume, Job Description, etc.)

2. Provide the Prompt Template

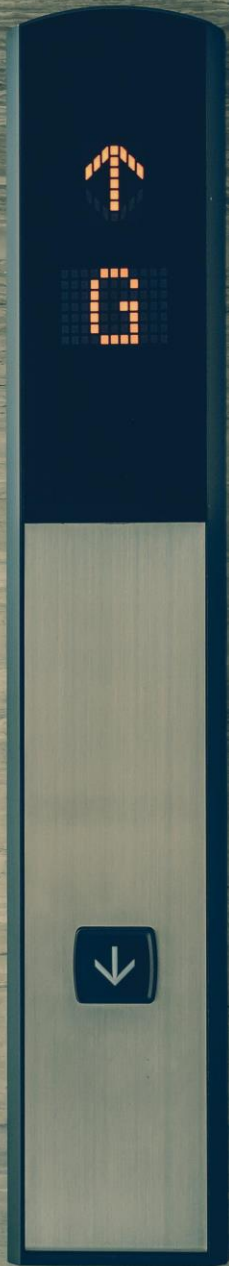
- **Paste the template** into the chat or **upload it as a file**

3. Submit the Request

- Example: **“Execute my Prompt Template.”**

4. AI Applies the Template

- The system **uses your files and instructions to generate the output**



ELEVATOR SPEECH: LEVERAGING AI WITH YOUR RESUME

- Typically, a 20–30 second professional introduction
- Communicates who you are and the value you deliver
- Aligned with your Target Resume and job narrative
- Creates interest and opens the conversation

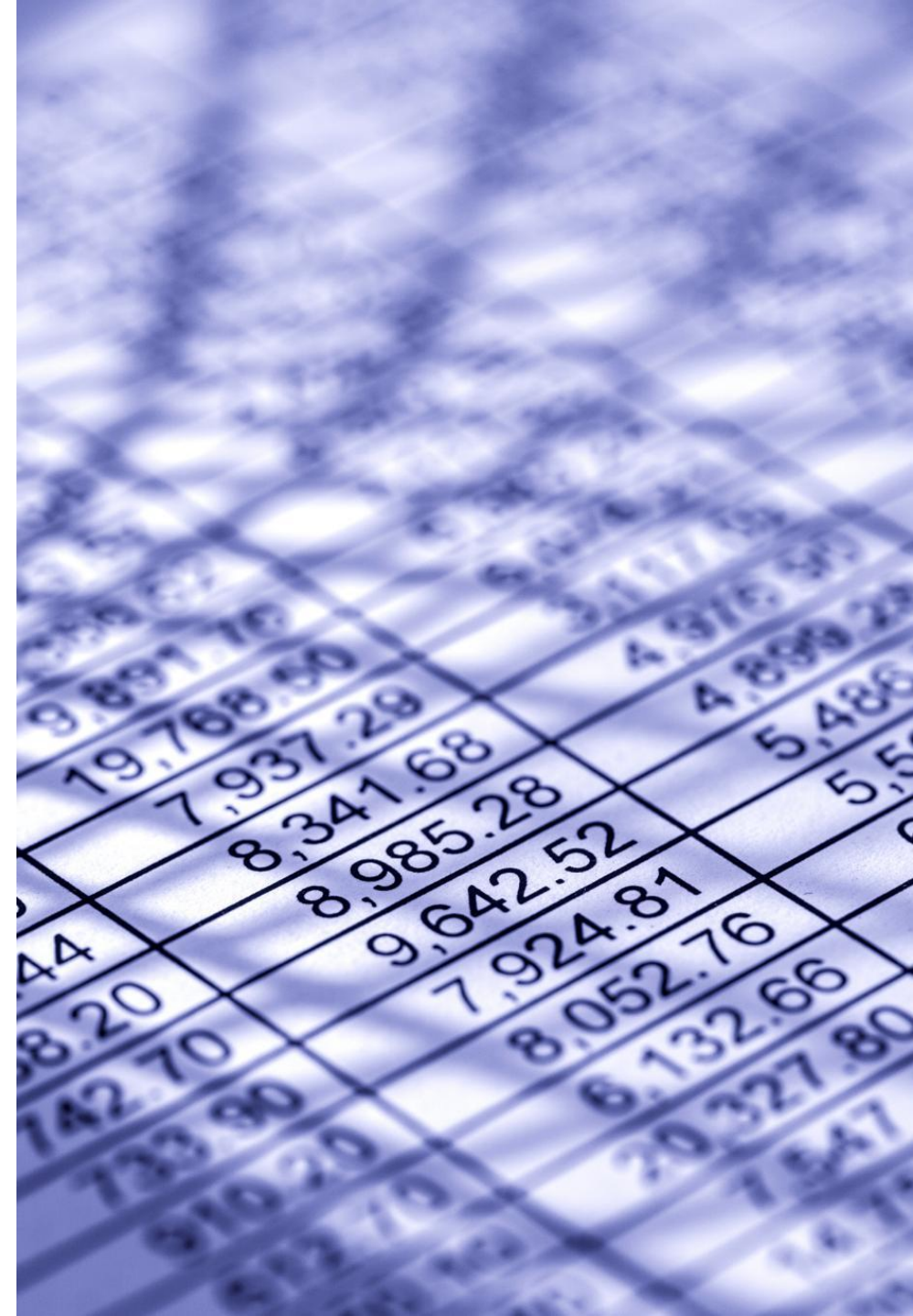

AI HALLUCINATIONS

What It Is

- AI can generate information that sounds correct but is wrong

Why It Happens

- AI predicts likely words based on patterns
- It does not check facts
- If information is missing or unclear, it may “fill in the blanks”

What This Means for You

- Use AI for drafting and refinement
- Always verify names, dates, metrics, and compliance details
- **You are responsible for accuracy!!!**

COMMON AI HALLUCINATION EXAMPLES

- **Invented Job Titles**

AI upgrades roles (e.g., “Senior Strategy Director” instead of “Risk Analyst”)

- **Wrong Employer Names**

AI replaces smaller firms with well-known companies

- **Incorrect Employment Dates**

AI extends dates or removes gaps in work history

- **Fabricated Metrics**

AI adds numbers that never existed (e.g., “Increased revenue by 47%”)

- **Added Skills You Don’t Have**

AI inserts commonly used tools (Python, Tableau, Kubernetes)

- **Inflated Project Scope**

AI turns small initiatives into large “transformations”

- **False Leadership Claims**

AI adds team management responsibilities that didn’t exist

- **Regulatory Frameworks You Never Used**

AI inserts standards like GDPR, SOX, HIPAA, or NIST automatically



AI PRIVACY

What it is

- Sensitive information can leave your control when it is entered into an AI system

When the risk occurs

- Data entered in prompts or uploaded files may be stored, logged, or processed by the AI system
- That information may be retained for system improvement, troubleshooting, or monitoring
- Access controls, system logs, or sharing settings may allow others to view the data

Key takeaway

- Do not enter confidential, regulated, or personal information into AI tools.

COMMON AI PRIVACY EXAMPLES

Personal Information Exposure

- Entering your home address, phone number, or full birth date into a prompt
- Uploading a resume that includes personal contact details
- Asking AI to summarize personal financial or medical information

Employer or Client Information Exposure

- Uploading documents with company financial projections or internal budgets
- Entering client names, internal systems, or proprietary processes
- Asking AI to analyze confidential reports or internal presentations

Key Takeaway

- AI tools do not share your prompts with other users. However, the information you enter may still be stored, reviewed, or used by the system provider.
 - Stored in system logs
 - Retained by the provider
 - Reviewed by humans for system improvement
 - Used in training depending on platform settings
 - Accessible to system administrators

AI BIAS

What it is

- AI may produce unfair or inaccurate results based on the data it was trained on.
- Results may favor certain roles, industries, or groups
- Can influence how experience, skills, or achievements are interpreted

How it happens

- AI is trained on large amounts of human-created data
- Historical data may contain imbalances or stereotypes
- The system predicts patterns that appear most common in the data

Key takeaway

- Review AI outputs carefully for fairness and accuracy
- Provide clear, verified inputs to guide results
- Use human judgment to ensure your story is accurate and balanced

AI BIAS EXAMPLES

- **Resume Screening**

AI trained on past hiring data may favor candidates from certain schools or companies.

Risk: Qualified candidates may be filtered out.

- **Keyword Matching**

AI may prioritize resumes with specific keywords even when other candidates have similar experience.

Risk: Strong candidates may be overlooked.

- **Language and Communication Style**

AI may favor resumes written in a style common in certain industries or corporate cultures.

Risk: Candidates with different backgrounds may be evaluated unfairly.

- **Experience Interpretation**

AI may value experience from large companies more than similar work at smaller organizations.

Risk: Relevant achievements may be undervalued.



EFFECTIVE RISK MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES

- Verify AI outputs before using or sharing
- Use clear, structured prompts
- Provide accurate information as input
- Edit and refine AI-generated content
- Understand AI limitations
